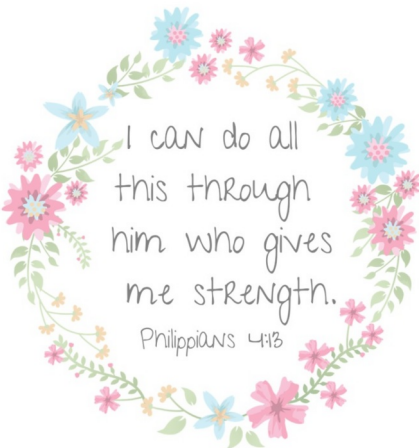


# News and Information
