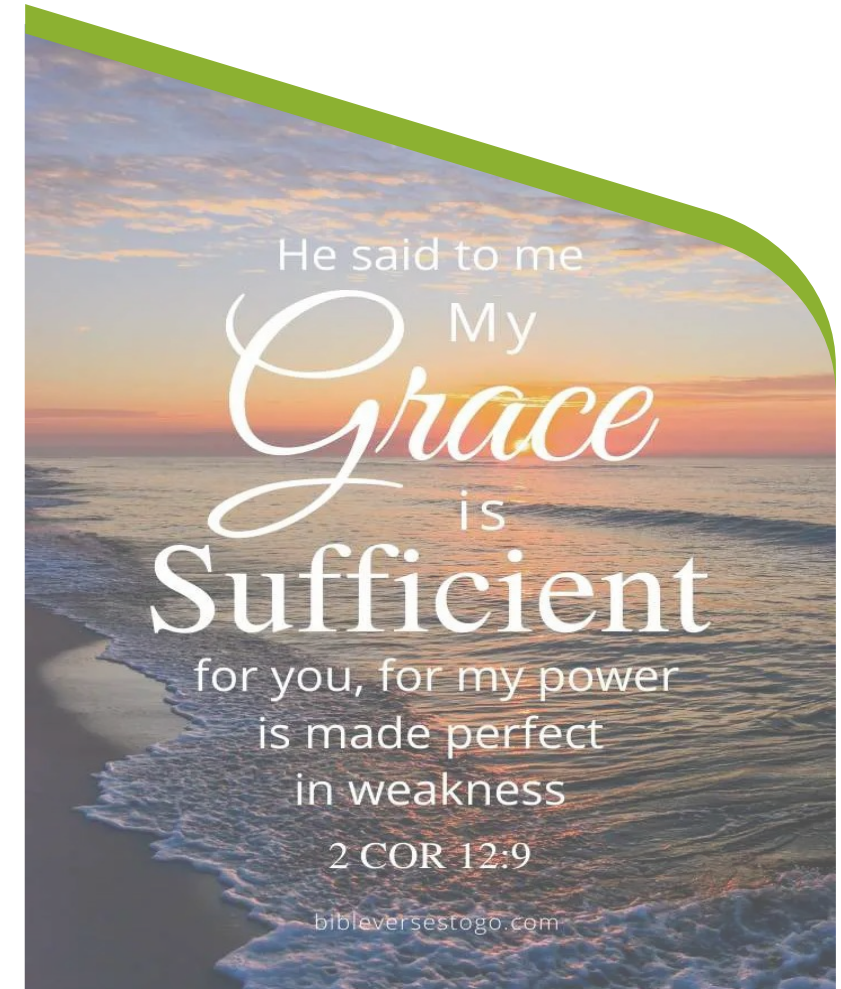

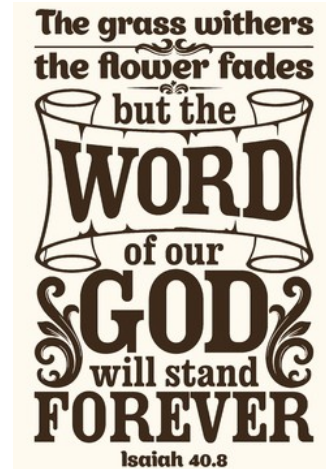
- ☞ **Transferring Out:** (Second Reading)
